**Chapter 16 of the Gospel of Mark in the tradition of biblical
translations into Old Slavic (10th–14th c.)**

Abstract

In my paper, I will first present the general history of the translation of biblical texts into Slavonic from the creation of the Slavonic alphabet by Cyril and Methodius in the ninth century to the preparation of the so-called “synodal” translation in the nineteenth century. The second point examined in this paper will be the transmission of manuscripts containing different ancient versions of the Gospel of Mark in Old Slavonic. Finally, in the third part of my paper, I will present a detailed analysis of the Old Slavonic texts of chapter 16 of Mark's Gospel in relation to the Greek texts of this chapter.
