## **The Ending(s) of Mark in Family 1**

In 1902 Kirsopp Lake published his groundbreaking study of *Codex 1 of the Gospels and its Allies*, a group of minuscules that became known as Family 1 ( $f^1$ ). Still today, the dominant handedition Nestle-Aland 28 cites Lake's textual reconstruction of this family in Mark (assuming that GA 1 is the "Leithandschrift") although progress has been made in our understanding of Family 1 (especially in Matthew and John) and new and important members have been discovered (in particular GA 2193). This paper revisits the text and paratext of Family 1 in the endings of Mark.
